Dear Senator Coats:

As the Committee begins its consideration of the FY2014 Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Bill, I am writing to request support for the following programmatic request included in the President's fiscal year 2014 budget:

Project Name: National Bio and Agro-defense Facility
Request: \$714,000,000
Account: Research, Development, Acquisition, and Operations
Office: Science and Technology
Agency: Department of Homeland Security
Project Location: Manhattan, Kansas

Project Description: This project will produce a state-of-the-art research and development facility to provide homeland security for the nation's food and agriculture supply. The facility will house biosecurity level (BSL) 3, BSL 3-Ag, and BSL-4 laboratories to conduct research and develop new medicine to combat the threat of a deadly biological pathogen intentionally or accidentally introduced into the United States plant and animal population. The president's budget request, in combination with state contributions equal to 25 percent of the total, would fund the project through construction completion.

Specifically, funding for the National Bio and Agro-defense Facility is listed in the President's Budget Overview for the Department of Homeland Security on page 104. Additionally, the account request can be located in the Budget's Appendix on pages 533-534.
