# U.S. SERVICE ACADEMY NOMINATIONS INFORMATION SHEET

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

As of July 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of admission, applicants must be:

- 17 years of age, but not yet 23
- A citizen of the United States
- Unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support a child or dependent
- A legal resident of the State of Kansas

## **NOMINATION PROCEDURES:**

To be considered for nomination by Senator Pat Roberts, all materials must be received by Gilda Lintz in Senator Roberts' Topeka Office by OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **THE COMPLETED NOMINATION APPLICATION FILE MUST CONTAIN:**

- Academy Application sheet which is included in the Nomination Packet
- Official school transcript sent from school counselor
- A detailed list of school, church, civic and extracurricular activities and any special honors received
- ACT and/or SAT score verification
- Three letters of recommendation, one of which must be from your high school counselor
- A recent photo (4 x 6)
- Affidavit of legal permanent residence (Form included in the Nomination Packet)
- A 250-500 word essay detailing why you desire to attend the academy of your choice.
- All applicants will be required to personally appear before Senator Roberts' Academy Screening Board.
